### **The Long Term Recovery Committee Chooses the Los Angeles Emergency Preparedness Foundation as Fiscal Agent**

Sylmar, CA – In an unanimous vote, the Long Term Recovery Committee has requested that the Los Angeles Emergency Preparedness Foundation (LAEPF) act as the official fiscal agent for funds allocated to victims of the 2008 Sayre Fire.

In response to this wildfire, the San Fernando Valley Long Term Recovery Group (SFV LTRG) was established for the “purpose of serving individuals impacted by the 2008 San Fernando Valley wildfires.” The LTRG plans to assist residents with long term recovery and is a coalition of community members, businesses, non-profits, and faith based organizations.
